



The Distance from Schiphol Airport to hotels in the city center is:

18.5 kilometers, 20 minutes by taxi depending on the traffic and costs approx. Euro 45.00. In addition, train station is located directly at Schiphol with direct connections to Amsterdam Central Station. The NH Barbizon Palace Hotel is across the street from the Central Station.
